Before you start, you should carefully read what you need to know and the tools to prepare.

Materials

1. Yarn: Bulky / Category 5

2. Color: Dark pink, light pink, baby pink, white, yellow and a little balck (size 2mm)

3. Hook size: 4.5mm

4. Sewing needle

5. Scissors

6. Fiberfill

7. Adhesive eyes: 12mm x2

8. Hot glue gun or craft glue

Abbreviations

MR: Magic Ring

st(s): Stitch(es)

sl st: Slip stitch

ch: Chain

SC: Single crochet

DC: Double crochet

HDC: Half double crochet

DC INC: 2DC in one st

HDC INC: 2HDC in one st

BO: Bobble stitch (3 loops)

INC: Increase

DEC: Decrease

NOTE

- You need to prepare 1 skein of dark pink and light pink; 50g of baby pink, yellow yarn; and a little balck yarn (size 2mm).
- The pattern is written using crochet terminology common in the US.
- The size of the finished piece may vary based on the yarn used and the tension of your stitches. The size is about 27cm ~ 10.53 inches.
- This pattern is intended for personal use only. Distribution or sharing of the pattern on social media or other platforms is prohibited.

IMPORTANT NOTE BEFORE STARTING TO CROCHET


End the round by slip stitching.

Most of my patterns use the 'end the round with slip stitch' technique. I feel it makes the stitches more aligned and prevents the finished piece from skewing to one side. Of course, you can also use the spiral technique. I feel that some crocheters may not be familiar with the correct operation of the finishing part, so please pay more attention to this section.

for the end the round:

- 1.To ensure proper end-of-round placement, you should use a stitch marker to mark your first crochet stitch.
- 2. After that, thread the needle through --> take the yarn and pull it through to execute the slip stitch. (images 2, 3, 4) After that, gently pull to tighten it a bit.
- 3. Yarn over and thread it through again to make a chain stitch, and then make the first crochet stitch again where you slipped into to finish the round. (images 5~11)

Here are some notes after finishing a round: chain 1 for SC and HDC, chain 2 for DC, chain 3 for TR or TRC.



HEAD

Use dark pink yarn

R1: 8SC in a MR (8)

R2: 8INC (16)

R3: (SC, INC) 8 times (24)

R4: (3SC, INC) 6 times (30)

R5: 30SC (30)

R6: (2SC, INC, 2SC) 6 times (36)

R7: (5SC, INC) 6 times (42)

R8: (8SC, 5INC, 8SC) 2 times (52)

R9: (7SC, INC, 10SC, INC, 7SC) 2 times (56)

R10-14: 56SC (56) 5 rounds total

R15: (7SC, DEC, 10SC, DEC, 7SC) 2 times (52)

R16: (8SC, 5DEC, 8SC) 2 times (42)

R17: (2SC, DEC, 2SC) 7 times (35)

R18: (3SC, DEC) 7 times (28)

Stuffing

R19: (SC, DEC, SC) 7 times (21)

R20: (SC, DEC) 7 times (14)

Stuffing

R21: 7DEC (7)

Weave in the ends and cut.













MOUTH

Use light pink yarn

Make 13CH, begin with the second CH from the hook (Work on the both sides of the chain):

R1: INC, 10SC, 4SC in one st, 10SC, INC (28)

R2: 2INC, 3SC, 2DEC, 3SC, 4INC, 20SC, 2INC (34)

R3: (HDC, HDC INC) 2 times, 2SC, 4slst, 2SC, (HDC INC, HDC) 2 times,

(INC, SC) 2 times, 10SC, (SC, INC) 2 times (42)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.

MOUTH (cont.)







TEETH

Use white yarn

Make 13CH, begin with the second CH from the hook (Work on the both sides of the chain):

11SC, [SC, (2CH, turn, SC), SC] in one st, 2SC, 6HDC, 2SC, [SC, (2CH, turn, SC)] in one st.

Weave in the ends, cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.







EYES (Make 2)

Use yellow yarn

R1: 6SC in a MR (6)

R2: 6INC (12)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing. Glue the eyes between R1 and R2.



NOSE

Use baby pink yarn

Make 4CH, begin with the second CH from the hook (Work on the both sides of the chain):

R1: INC, SC, 4SC in one st, SC, INC (10)

R2: INC, 3SC, 2INC, 3SC, INC (14)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.



EARS (Make 2)

Use dark pink yarn

R1: 6SC in a MR (6)

R2: (SC, INC) 3 times (9)

R3: (SC, INC, SC) 3 times (12)

R4: (3SC, INC) 3 times (15)

R5: 15SC (15)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.



FUR (Make 2)

Use dark pink yarn

Make 11CH, begin with the second CH from the hook RIGHT:

SC, HDC, [DC, (2CH, turn, SC), DC] in one st, HDC, SC, slst,

SC, [HDC, (2CH, turn, SC), HDC] in one st, SC, slst (14)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.


LEFT:

SC, [HDC, (2CH, turn, SC), HDC] in one st, SC, slst,

SC, HDC, [DC, (2CH, turn, SC), DC] in one st, HDC, SC, slst (14)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.

FUR (cont.)







ASSEMBLY OF THE HEAD

- Sew the ears from R3 to R9, with the two ears 13 SC apart at R3 (Image 1, 2).
- Sew the fur from R2 to R9, on the front side of the ears (Image 3, 4).
- Sew the mouth from R8 to R14, with the mouth 5 SC away from the fur at R9 (Image 5, 6).
- Sew the nose and stuff with fiberfill (Image 7).
- Sew the eyes above the nose (Image 8).
- Sew the teeth under the nose, about 1 row below the nose (Image 9).
- Attach the yarn between R13 and R14 (6 SC from the mouth), crochet the fur:

Right side: [(3CH, turn, 2SC), slst] 3 times. Crochet similarly on the Left side, but in the opposite direction (Image 10, 11, 12).



ASSEMBLY OF THE HEAD (cont.)



- Use black yarn to sew a straight line between the nose and the mouth.
- Use black yarn to sew the whiskers and the details on the teeth.



FRONT LEGS (Make 2)

Begin with light pink yarn

You'll switch to dark pink yarn when the text is bold and underlined.

R1: 6SC in a MR (6)

R2: 6INC (12)

R3: 3SC, [BO (3 loops), SC] 3 times, 3SC (12)

R4-5: 12SC (12) 2 rounds total R6-9: <u>12SC</u> (12) 3 rounds total

R10-12: 12SC (12) 3 rounds total

Stuffing


R13-15: <u>12SC</u> (12) 3 rounds total R16-18: 12SC (12) 3 rounds total

R19: 12SC (12) *Stuffing*
Weave in the ends and cut.





FRONT LEGS (cont.)









BACK LEGS (Make 2)

Crochet similarly to the front legs from R1 to R8.

R9: 3slst, HDC, 4DC INC, HDC, 3slst (12)

Stuffing

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.



BODY

Begin with dark pink yarn

You'll switch to light pink yarn when the text is bold and underlined.

R1: 8SC in a MR (8)

R2: 8INC (16)

R3: (SC, INC) 8 times (24)

R4: (SC, INC, SC) 8 times (32)

R5: (3SC, INC) 8 times (40)

R6: (2SC, INC, 2SC) 8 times (48)

R7: (5SC, INC) 8 times (56)

R8: <u>(3SC, INC, 3SC)</u> 8 times (64)

R9: 64SC (64)

R10: <u>7SC, (3SC, DEC)</u> 10 times, 7SC (54)

R11-12: 54SC (54) 2 rounds total

R13: 7SC, (4SC, DEC, 4SC) 4 times, 7SC (50)

R14-16: <u>50SC</u> (50) 3 rounds total

R17-18: 50SC (50) 2 rounds total





BODY (cont.)

R19: 7SC, (2SC, DEC, 2SC) 6 times, 7SC (44)

R20: 44SC (44)

R21: 4SC, (2SC, DEC, 2SC) 6 times, 4SC (38)

R22: 38SC (38)

Stuffing

R23: 3SC, (3SC, DEC, 3SC) 4 times, 3SC (34)

R24: Join both edges of the leg, with the toes facing inward as shown in the image:

5SC, 6SC join with the front leg 1, 12SC, 6SC join with the front leg 2, 5SC (34)

R25: 2SC, (2SC, DEC, 2SC) 5 times, 2SC (29)

R26: SC, (DEC, SC) 9 times, SC (20)

R27: 10DEC (10) *Stuffing*

Weave in the ends and cut.

















TAIL

Begin with light pink yarn

R1: 6SC in a MR (6)

R2: (SC, INC) 3 times (9)

R3: (SC, INC) 4 times, SC (13)

R4: (SC, INC) 6 times, SC (19)

R5: (SC, INC, SC) 6 times, SC

(25)

R6: (2SC, INC, 2SC) 5 times (30)

TAIL (cont.)

When the text is bold and underlined, switch to dark pink yarn.

R7-R9: 30SC (30) 3 rounds total

R10-12: 30SC (30) 3 rounds total

R13-15: 30SC (30) 3 rounds total

R16: 30SC (30)

R17: (2SC, DEC, 2SC) 5 times (25)

R18: 25SC (25) *Stuffing*

R19: (3SC, DEC) 5 times (20)

R20: **20SC** (20)

R21: (SC, DEC, SC) 5 times (15)

R22-23: 15SC (15) 2 rounds total

R24: (SC, DEC) 5 times (10) *Stuffing*

R25-27: 10SC (10) 3 rounds total

R28-30: 10SC (10) 3 rounds total

(For the last 6 rows, stuff lightly)

Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.







ASSEMBLY

- Sew the head onto the top of the legs, from R26 to R29 (Image 1, 2, 3).
- Sew the front legs at the marked points (Image 4, 5).
- Sew the back legs starting from R9, attaching the legs closely to the body (Image 6, 7).
- Sew the tail onto R1 (Image 8).
- Adjust the shape of the tail as needed.

ASSEMBLY (cont.)
