- Color D: blue **YarnArt Jeans** 33 (50g, 160m)
- Color E: yellow **YarnArt Jeans** 35 (50g, 160m)
- Color F: red **YarnArt Jeans** 26 (50g, 160m)
- Color G: off white **YarnArt Jeans** 03 (50g, 160m)
- Color H: beige **YarnArt Jeans** 07 (50g, 160m)

### Other materials

- Crochet hook size 2.5mm
- 1 pairs of safety eyes size 6mm
- Tapestry needles, brown thread, pins, stitch markers, scissors, polyester fiberfill

Break the yarn, weave in the last 6 sts, hide the remaining yarn (pic 1).

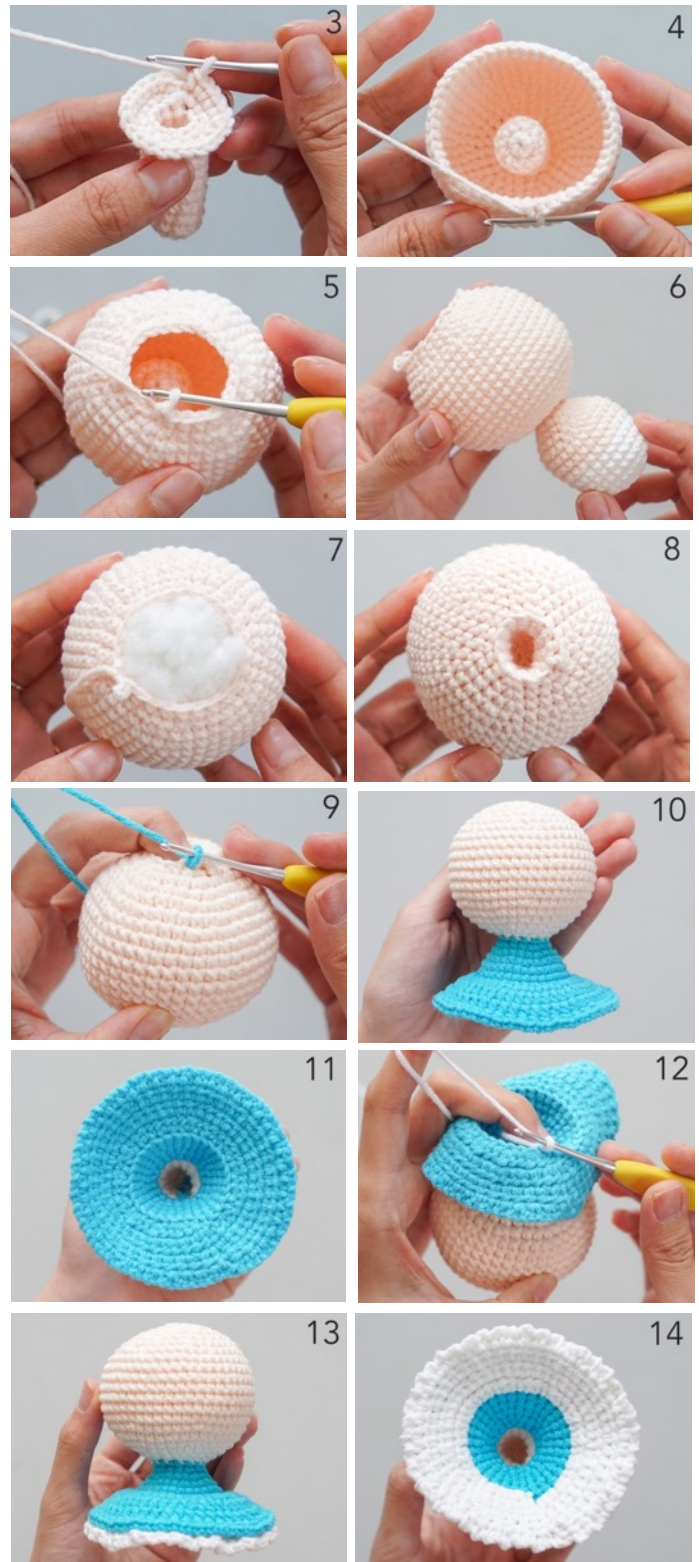

Break the yarn (pic 10-11). Join yarn A on the 1st st of the blo on rnd 7 (pic 12), continue to crochet:

Break the yarn. Wear the hair on the head (pic 19-20-21). Insert the 6mm eyes between rnd 18&19, 8 sts apart. Use brown thread to embroider eyelashes & eyebrows.

3	Repeat rnd 2	(24)

Break the yarn with a really long rest, sew 2 edegs together. Wrap the remaining yarn around the bowtie.



### Bowtie's band (yarn C)

1	ch 54, start on the 3rd st from the hook, hdc 52, slst on the 1st ch	(52)

Break the yarn, sew 2 edegs together, and then sew the bowtie to the band (pic 22).

Break the yarn, hide the remaining yarn (pic 29).  
Wear the apron on Alice (pic 30-31).

5	sc 5, dec 4, sc 5, start stuffing	(14)
6	sc 3, dec 4, sc 3, change to yarn A	(10)

Break the yarn with a long rest, sew the legs on the sitting body (make sure the sitting body can touch the ground without falling)-pic 32.



Insert the sitting/standing body inside the head (pic 33-34).

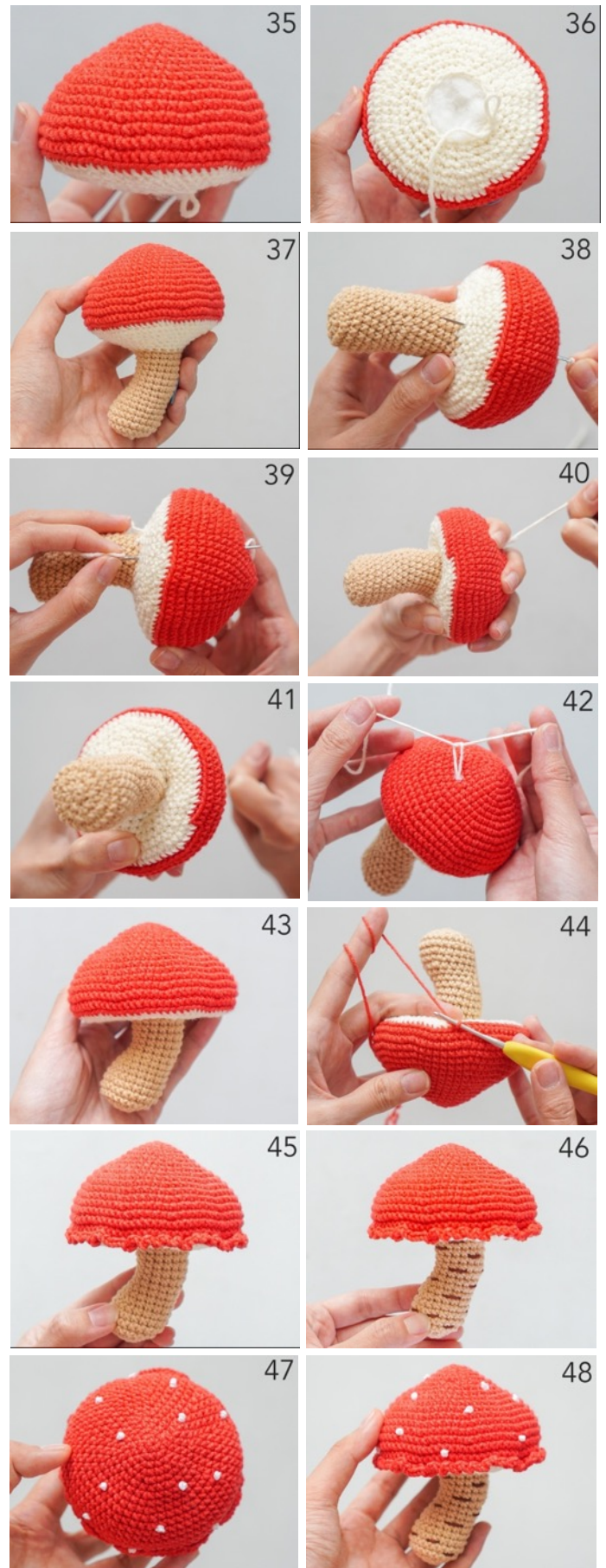

Break the yarn, weave in the last 6 sts (pic 37). Cut a piece of yarn G, use tapestry needle (pic 38), pull through 3 sts on rnd 23 (pic 39-40). Pull really hard to create a dent as pic 41, tie a knot (pic 42), cut and hide the remaining yarn (pic 43). Continue to do it for the remaining sts on rnd 23 (this would make the mushroom shorter and look more real). Join yarn F on the 1st st of the flo on rnd 17 (pic 44), crochet: \*sc 1, ch 1\*, repeat \*\* till the end, slst on the 1st sc (pic 45).

Use brown thread to make the lines on the mushroom (pic 46), use white thread to make **French knots** on top of the mushroom (pic 47-48).

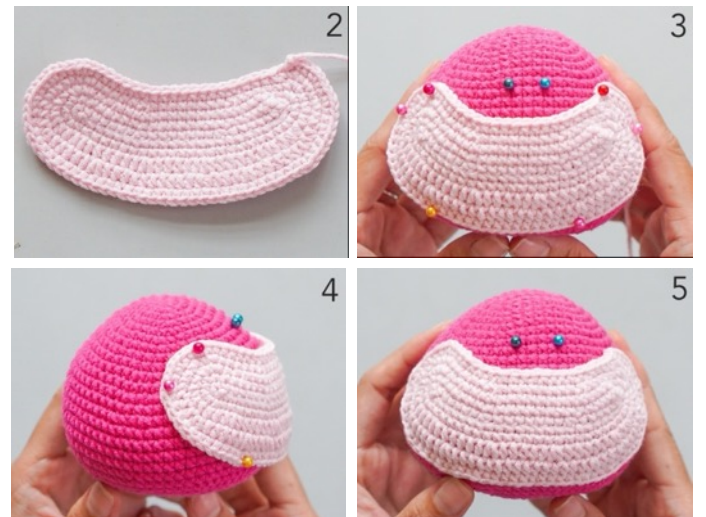

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later (pic 6). Use pins to locate the teeth on the face-pic 7 & use tapestry needle to sew the 1st & last st of the teeth on the face (we will use black thread to fix the teeth later).

### Eyes (yarn D, X2)

1	sc 7 into a magic loop (7)
2	inc 7, slst on the 1st st (14)

Break the yarn, insert black safety eyes on the eyes, then insert the eyes between rnd 8&9 of the head (pic 8).

### Nose (yarn A)

rnd	sts
1	ch 6, start on the 2nd st from the hook, sc 4, (sc 3) <i>in the last stitch</i> , continue to crochet on the other side, sc 3, inc (12)
2	inc, sc 3, inc 3, sc 3, inc 2 (18)
3	sc 3, inc 2, sc 13 (20)
4	sc 4, inc 2, sc 14 (22)

Break the yarn, sew the nose right below the eyes (pic 9). Use black thread to embroider the teeth line & whiskers (pic 10-11). Use darker pink yarn/thread to sew a line between the face (pic 12-13).

### Whiskers (yarn A, X2)

1	ch 10, start on the 5th st from the hook, slst 1, [ch 4, slst on the next st] 5x

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later.



### Right Eyebrow (yarn A)

rnd	sts
1	ch 5, start on the 2nd st from the hook, sc, hdc, dc, tr, ch 4, start on the 2nd st from the hook, sc, hdc, dc

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later.

### Left Eyebrow (yarn A)

rnd	sts
1	ch 4, start on the 2nd st from the hook, sc, hdc, dc, ch 5, start on the 2nd st from the hook, sc, hdc, dc, tr

Break the yarn with a long rest to sew later.



## INSTRUCTIONS

Use tapestry needle to sew the Whiskers from rnd 10-rnd 14 of the head, 2 sts apart from the face. Sew the right & left eyebrow above the eyes 3-4 rnds, 3 sts apart (pic 14-15).

### 1.What is X-shape stitch/V-shape stitch? Which one is better?

X-shape stitch or V-shape stitch depends on the way you pull the yarn through the loop. If you yarn over the hook from back to front, you're making a V-shape stitch. If you yarn under the hook, then it's a X-shape stitch. Both ways are fine, you can crochet whichever you find easier.

V-shape stitch helps your amigurumi look bigger, while X-shape stitch makes your amigurumi more beautiful and helps to make the amigurumi tighter.

### 2.Right side vs wrong side? Which one is correct?

You can see the difference between the right side and wrong side in the photos bellow.

When you crochet mini-sized toys/dolls, it is unable to turn the sides. Therefore, it is normal having the wrong side out.

### 3.Hide the yarn

For the remaining yarn, you can use a tapestry needle and weave it vertically through stitches. Repeat a couple times to make sure it stays firmly.

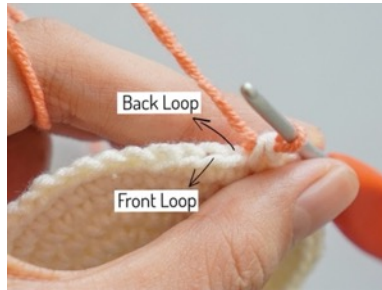
### 6.Invisible Decrease

Normal decrease (photo bellow) will make a large hole, so we should use insivible decrease. Just crochet on front loop only.
